7. The applicant to provide proof of security clearance by a competent authority to store and handle Ammonium Nitrate.
8. Copy of detailed emergency response and evacuation plans specific to AN5.1 incident scenario.
9. Provide copies of appropriate training programmes and plans in place to provide employee update knowledge and skills in safety management of AN 5.1 DGs.
10. Evidence of compliance with other internationally accepted standards for storing DG cargoes including AN cargoes.
11. Provide proof of past experience of storing AN Class 51 DG's safely in local or foreign ports including tonnage handled
