- 6. Copy of the detailed safety and security plan specific to the handling of AN cargoes.
- 7. The applicant to provide proof of security clearance by a competent authority to import Ammonium Nitrate.
- 8. Copy of detailed emergency response and evacuation plans specific to AN5.1 incident scenario.
- 9. Provide copies of appropriate training programmes and plans in place to provide employee update knowledge and skills in safety management of AN 5.1 DGs.
- 10. Evidence of compliance with other internationally accepted standards for handling of DG cargoes including AN cargoes.
- 11. Provide proof of past experience of import of AN Class 51 DG's safely in local or foreign ports including tonnage handled
- 12. Any other relevant documents to support your application
